Dear Mr. President,

The President and the US Government have actively supported the heroic fight of Ukrainian Army and people against the invading Russian Federation.

Both the Democrat and Republican parties are also united with the President and approved in Congress the large expenditures proposed by you to help the Ukrainian people defeat the Russian invasion.

This time more than ever since the Second World War, the United States has demonstrated to the world the human civilization built on the peoples' freedom and independence shall be adequately protected against the forces of brutality and immorality.

Communist regimes have been eliminated across the globe. Still, some residues of them remain as deadly as the case of Russian Federation President Vladimir Putin, who is invading neighboring Ukraine and threatening world peace.

In East Asia, North Korea disregards proposals for nuclear disarmament to get relief from embargoes and continuously increased the production of these dangerous weapons targeting South Korea, Japan and as far as the USA as they claimed.

But China is still the most significant threat with its expansion plans, occupying the territorial waters of countries in the region, threatening to invade Taiwan, and controlling the world's most important waterway from the Indian Ocean to the Pacific Ocean.

Particularly, Socialist Vietnam with its ambiguous standing for a long time, submitted to China and seeking help from the United States, abstained while 141 out of 193 nations voted in UNO General Assembly against the Russian invasion of Ukraine.

This unworthy attitude proves that the Communist Party of Vietnam cannot cleanse the mind of Stalin worship. Stalin, the tyrant who tried to eradicate the Ukrainian people and caused the famine that killed 4 to 6 million people in the country from 1931 to 1933 through the policy of collectivization and expropriation, collecting farmers' wheat, and simultaneously forbidding them from moving to the city to get food!

The same policy was fully applied in South Vietnam after the North Vietnamese Communists invaded the Republic of Vietnam in April 1975, causing severe food shortages and widespread poverty that forced the communists to "renovate" (doi moi) a market economy but with a socialist tail.

Thanks to the richness of the South and the primarily agricultural economy, hunger was overcome. However, bribery, corruption, and appropriation of public property have spread throughout the country by the party's abuse of the abundance of foreign direct investments after doi moi.

In the political arena, nothing has changed. Human rights are still trampled, and the elections of the President, Prime Minister, legislative members, even the committees of provinces, cities and villages are decided by the Communist Party.

Externally, Socialist Republic of Vietnam is still dependent on China with the "4 NOs" as stipulated in the 2019 White Paper of the Ministry of Defense, to become a ready prey for Chinese annexation :

- 1-SRVN does not advocate nor join any military alliances,
- 2-SRVN does not associate with one country to fight against another,

3- SRVN does not allow foreign countries to set up military bases nor use Vietnam's territory to fight other countries,

4 -SRVN does not use force nor threaten to use force in international relations.

A situation opposite to that of Ukraine, which campaigned for alignment with the West shortly after the dissolution of the Russian-Soviet Empire in 1991, and that is why now the West, led by the United States, wholeheartedly help the heroic Ukrainians to defend their country, effectively resisting the second military superpower in the world.

An unprecedented large scale support alliance in history is becoming a significant lesson for neighboring countries with rogue or hostile great powers.

Selecting and seeking cooperation, alliance, or common defense with one or more large, powerful, friendly countries is an absolute priority that must be made to be helped in effective self-defense when being invaded.

This is the essential part of the foreign policy of the Republic of Vietnam's Government De Jure, due to its deep awareness of the need to associate with the United States and other democratic countries to protect the homeland in times of danger and for the country's development right after the restoration of freedom and democracy.

With more than 100 million people united in the same mind and consensus, the post-Communist future Vietnam will be an essential component in the strategic position of Southeast Asia. It will contribute to security defense for the entire East Asia-Pacific region.

The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) will also purge the organization, replacing Putin's pro-Russian Socialist Vietnam and Xi Jinping's belligerent dependence on China, to welcome the newly free, democratic Vietnam and build together a prosperous Southeast Asia, closely cooperating with the United States and other democratic countries in the development of common interests and consolidating world peace.

With confidence in the historic mission of protecting the peoples' freedom that God has entrusted the United States, I ask the President to accept the deep admiration of most Vietnamese people that I represent and convey to you today, in the decisive hour of the confrontational test between dictatorship and democracy, independence of a nation and violence of its aggressor, the world's safety and a madman threatening to destroy a part of humanity.
